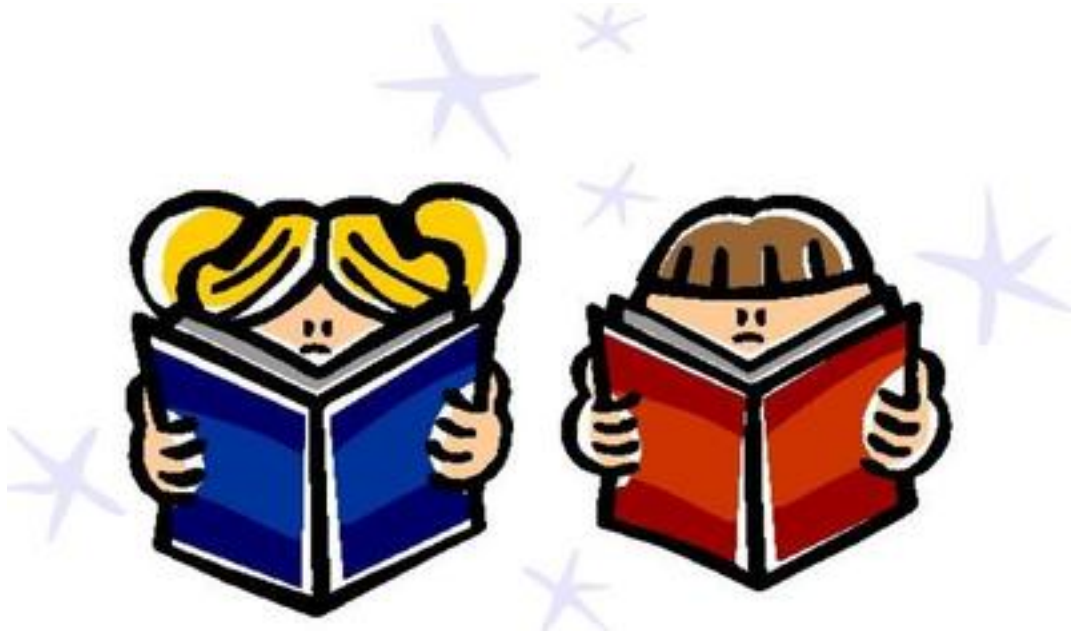


**Interested in learning what to listen for
